<u>Ultimate Makeup Guide</u>

Note*: Please wear your glasses on stage if you need to! Our doll masks are also able to be worn underneath glasses.

Your vision is very important (spot your head in your turns, wink)!

Junior Corps: Seraphim, Celestial, Royal Guard

Pressed powder on forehead. Lipstick and blush. Eye makeup only if you desire, See product list below.

Soldiers, Miniature Dolls(Mini Soldiers, Mini Arabian, Mini Spanish, Mini Chinese,) Harlequin, Columbina, Russian Doll

Specialty Makeup

<u>Dolls</u> wear half-masks that cover the eyes and nose, wardrobe will provide you with specialty makeup to complete a doll lip. Diagram included below. <u>Soldiers</u> will have the same makeup as Junior Corps. But wardrobe volunteers will give all soldiers red cheeks with provided makeup. Diagram included below. Party Girls, Party Boys, Angels, Candy Canes, Bonbons

Eyeshadow on eyelid, darkest where the eyeball ends, brighten center of eyelid. Add small wing eyeliner on top lashline, and lightly underline your lower lashline with black or dark brown eyeliner pencil. Powder on forehead and nose, lots of blush, lipstick.

Foundation and concealer optional, but face powder is a must. <u>Party boys</u> will wear muted lipstick and lighter blush. See product list below.

Adult dancers, Snow Queen, Snowflakes, Sugar Plum Fairy, Sugar Fairies, Spanish, Arabian, Cake Princess, Candles, Chinese Soloists and Corps, Russian, Flowers

Stage makeup

Foundation, concealer, face powder (non-optional), eyeshadow (cut-crease style), liquid eyeliner on top lashline, white eyeliner on lower waterline, black/dark brown eyeliner under lower lashline. False eyelashes, blush, lipstick, eyebrow pencil.

Party Men, Nutcracker, Snow King, Cavalier

Face powder on nose and forehead is a must to reduce shine reflecting from stage lights. Feel free to use any other makeup you desire. See product list below.

<u>EYESHADOW</u>

A warm-toned **brown** palette is the most flattering under stage lights. A lighter shade and a darker shade are ideal. Brand and colour optional, please choose according to your skin tone.

BLUSH

Essence 'the blush' - Shade 20 Bespoke

Use this blush as a colour guide. Please find a match that suits you and your skin tone. No shimmer is preferred, but not mandatory.

POWDER

Pressed or loose powder to match your skin tone. This is a must have product!

EYELINER and MASCARA/LASHES

Please stick to waterproof eyeliner/mascara for performances. Must be **black**.

False eyelashes are optional for stage makeup. Don't forget to bring your own eyelash glue, and practice applying at home!

FOUNDATION/CONCEALER

Please use own brand/colour if you do decide to use. Recommended products listed below otherwise.

Please refrain from using any heavy bronzer, highlighter, or contour on stage as it can create harsh lines on your face. Please do NOT share makeup, and always check the expiry date of your products. These makeup guides will only enhance your wonderful expressions!
